The school currently has strength of 1100 students and 72 Staff & support staff. A child admitted in Pre -

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of our institution. Class X results of the school prove without an iota of doubt that our students have made us proud.

You will be glad to know that the students have secured 100% result. More than 85% students scored between 75 % - 100% marks. The top scorer secured 97.1 % marks.

Co curricular Activities

By providing a conducive and encouraging environment, the students are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and Interschool activities/camp. It

enables the students to grow with confidence & knowledge & enhance their all round development.

Some of the activities taken up are planting trees, use of dustbins, not using poly bags and doing away with silver foils.

Best out of waste and Swacchta Pakhwada was taken up in September for 15 days, where in community outreach programmes were organized in slum areas.

SENSITISING TOWARDS ENVIRONMENT

Walkathon is a most popular and a regular feature of our school and this year the students and teachers reached out to the general masses in the form of large

In times of need, it is our basic responsibility to help those who need it & with this thought, the students every year donate clothes to the needy.

Various sewa programme throughout the year were conducted and as a result our students have become more humble and are contributing in their own small way towards society.

To add new flavor to the daily assemblies, themes are given to corresponding sections of the school, along with one day being dedicated to any special occasion.

Various clubs are introduced for skill development and to generate inquisitiveness and interest in students.

Interclass working Model making competition was conducted which was judged by the parents and many budding scientists were identified.

To make students good and law abiding citizens, we have been taking up activities like imparting knowledge about traffic rules to ensure that our children become responsible drivers, pedestrians, cyclists and passengers.

As a regular practice every year this session, also began with orientation programme for the parents of the students. The programme made the parents aware of the schemes of education we impart here at school. Query resolving session by a psychologist illuminated the path of positive parenting.

To take part is what counts in competition and lessons of victory and defeat are what we get in return. This environment was sufficiently created through inter-school, inter house and inter class competitions such as debates, Quiz, rangoli, Declamation, Creative

writing, Spelling –Bee, Poetry, Drawing, Model making, poster- making, calligraphy.

EDUCATIONAL TRIPS:

All efforts are made to ensure to help children of all grades to learn through visual experience, hence various field trips are organized throughout the year for children and teachers to boots their minds to create curiosity.

MOCK PARLIAMENT

The young minds are provided platform for holistic learning in the form of mock parliament sessions intra and inter schools where they learn to take quick decisions, team work, expressing their views, standing by each other and learn to form opinion on issues of national importance. HEALTH CHECK UPS

To assess normal development of the child, regular, general health and dental checks have been conducted during this session.

A step forward was taken and a health check up for all staff members was conducted by ESIC MODEL HOSPITAL Bari Brahmana to rule out any health issues amongst staff members.

CAREER GUIDANCE

A career counselling session to help students to choose a field that is in time with their skills and their job expectations was organised for senior students.

To ensure that our society is well equipped with the knowledge to face any challenge, we have focused sessions on special topics like Disaster Management and one such initiative was taken by our students where they filmed a video to educate the common

masses as how to prepare oneself in times of Natural calamity.

School up gradation & improvement programme.

The school has been upgraded to a senior secondary level and Medical, Non Medical, Commerce students are being mentored by the best of the faculty.

Swimming pool has been set up for the students. Additional Music room with a female Music Teacher is being used.

10 well ventilated, spacious classrooms have been made functional for the new Session.

All kindergarten busses have been given maids.

New Ac/Non AC vehicles have been added to the existing fleet of school owned vehicles according to the requirement of the students.

The school building has been given a facelift and play field is all functional under the able guidance of our expert coaches.

The essence of Digital India lies in the knowledge of technology and its effective use. Therefore, besides smart classes, Byjus classes have been an added feature this year.

I am proud to announce that our school has tied up with a Lead school which is a system based on 5 pillars of excellent schools. Sports

4. Roller Skating Federation of India organised a skating championship in Vishakhapatnam and Manit Chambyal got 5th Position.
5. In Roller Skating Competition held in Delhi Public School, Ahmadabad (Gujarat) – 7 Gold medals were bagged by Vansh Charak, Giriman, Tushar Bamotra, kapis Kumar, Ansh Chanotra, Kavya Sharma, Nipun Bhagat,, 5 silver medals were captured by Simranjeet Singh, Panshul Gupta, Ridhvan Sharma, Pranav Verma, Ridhvic Mangotra and 1 bronze medal was won by Pritish Charak.
6. Manit Chambyal got 4th position in skating competition organised by School Federation Games of India in Karnataka.

7. Under the banner of Sahodaya Complex Manit Chambyal also showed his determination by capturing a gold medal, Jaiaditya walked away with a silver medal and Aniket kotwal, Saurav Charak and Hargun bagged bronze medal in the skating competition.

Shooting

1. In an Inter- district state level shooting championship organised by Department of youth services and sports Aditya Sharma and Vansh Charak won Gold medal, Vivan Sharma bagged silver medal and Manish walked away with the bronze medal.
2. Himanshu Gupta attained 4th position, Naina Saini was placed at 10th in 29th All India Mavalankar Championship in the Rifle shooting event, Sainath and Akhileshwar Singh Charak with a score of 380 and 370 qualified for the prestigious National Championship.

3. Aneesha Sharma and Adhiraj Singh Charak did us all proud by capturing prestigious place in the Project LEAP -2019. The duo competed with more than 350 participants and out of 32 selected were the only two from J & K and from our school.

Speed Ball
